- Correction to Pastor Sarah's report. Should read.
 Churchwide Strategic Ministry Grants and SAWC Grants were reduced by 10% for 2024 across all synods in the ELCA. This impacts the following ministries:
 - Salem Lutheran Church, Toledo-2023-\$14,000 to 2024-\$12,600
 - o Redeemer Lutheran Church, Toledo- 2023 \$14,000 to 2024- \$12,600
 - Camino de Vida, Fremont-2023-\$10,000 to 2024-\$9,000
 Total reduction of \$3800. Pastor Sarah has been in conversation with these ministry's leadership. Please pray about how we might support these important ministries.

9. Financial Reports and 2024/25 Mission Spending Plan

Action SC24.03 Approval of the 2024/25 Mission Spending Plan

"Synod Council approves the 2024/25 Mission Spending Plan."

Motion to approve by Pastor Melanie Haack and second by Pastor Ashley Rosa-Ruggieri.

Discussion: St. John's at the Bay line item of \$2,000 is no longer needed. The line item was removed at the request of St. John, Port Clinton. Clark Price moved to amend the motion that the St. John's at the Bay line item be re-allocated to the line items: Redeemer, Toledo \$750, Salem, Toledo \$750 and Camino de Vida \$500.

Synod Council renewed the authorization of Redeemer and Salem as Strategic Ministries. Additional funds of \$1800 were then proportionally added to Redeemer, Salem, and Camino de Vida to help offset the loss in ELCA grant funding.

New totals are for the 2024-25 Mission Spending Plan are: Redeemer, Toledo = \$11,400 Salem, Toledo = \$11,400 Camino de Vida = \$10,000
