## b. Action SC25.04 Approval of the Annual Disbursement Limit from Endowment Fund

"At the recommendation of the Finance Team the Annual Disbursement Limit from the Endowment Fund shall be set at \$65,000 which is around 5.8%"

The motion to approved was made by Wendy Bauer and seconded by Pastor Ashley Rosa-Ruggieri. Motion was approved.

#### 12. Administrative Updates

- a. Bishop Daniel will be working with the Executive Committee in February 2025 to purchase a used vehicle to replace the synod vehicle he currently uses for Synod business, which is a 2014 Ford Escape with 205,000 miles. 2022-2024 Used Ford Escapes are currently priced between \$25-27,000. Funds for this purchase are currently available in the Synod's Operating Assets Fund.

- c. Cassie Mugler shared that she is working with a new database and asked all council members to send her a picture.
